- 2. Complete and sign the worksheet—you and your custodial parent must sign this worksheet.
- 3. Talk to your financial aid administrator if you have questions about completing this worksheet.
- Submit the completed worksheet and any other documents the Financial Aid Office requests to the Financial Aid
 Office.
