- IWU awards credit in “units” and not in “semester” hours. One unit at Illinois Wesleyan is equivalent to four semester hours. Therefore, a three-semester hour course is equivalent to .75 units.
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses with scores of 3, 4, or 5 will earn one course unit of elective credit. AP scores of 4 or 5 may also earn IWU Shared Curriculum attributes or transfer as a specific IWU class.
- Dual credit courses must have a grade of “C” or better to be accepted.
- IWU participates in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI). If you attend Heartland and complete an Associate in Arts Degree, IWU will accept that as a general education package. Please see the Heartland Community College transfer plans for more information.
- Many Career and Technical education courses, such as nursing assistant, will not transfer. Life Success will not transfer for credit to Illinois Wesleyan.
